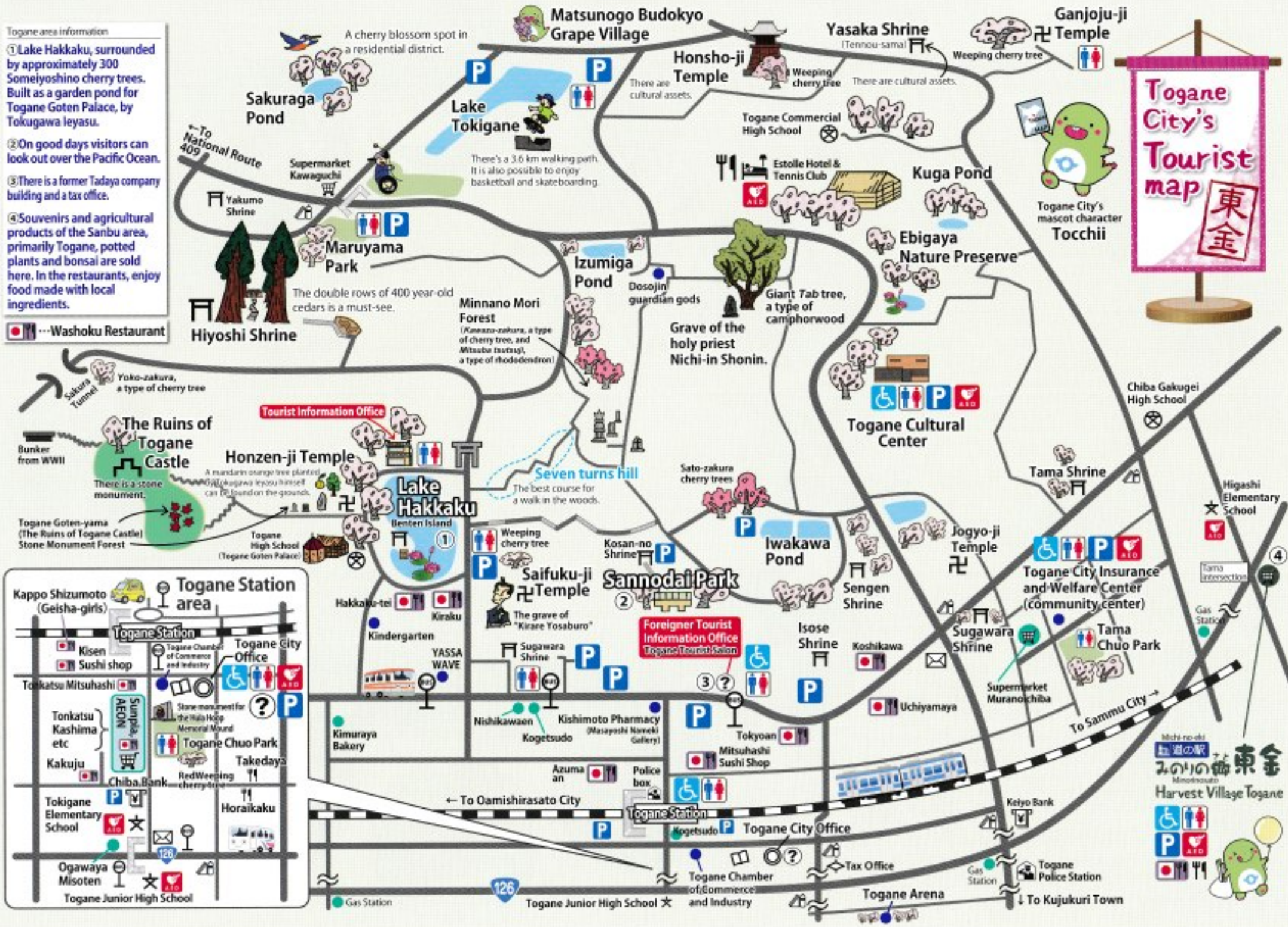


Togane area information

- ① Lake Hakkaku, surrounded by approximately 300 Someiyoshino cherry trees. Built as a garden pond for Togane Goten Palace, by Tokugawa Ieyasu.
- ② On good days visitors can look out over the Pacific Ocean.
- ③ There is a former Tadayu company building and a tax office.
- ④ Souvenirs and agricultural products of the Sanbu area, primarily Togane, potted plants and bonsai are sold here. In the restaurants, enjoy food made with local ingredients.

From late March and into April, the city is painted with the blossoms of many cherry trees. Also, there are many events at Lake Hakkaku, where the cherry blossoms are lit up at night making beautiful reflections in the lake. During this time, there is also a fireworks festival so it is possible to enjoy both the cherry blossoms and fireworks competing for your attention.



This roadside station has various shops, such as Togane Marche, selling local specialty products and fresh agricultural products, Tocino, an Italian restaurant that uses local ingredients, and Ryokkaboku Ichiba, which displays and sells potted plants and bonsai, flowers, etc. There is also an event space in this industry interchange facility. From December to May it is possible to pick strawberries.

[Togane Cherry Blossom Festival]



Welcome to Togane,
a city with abundant nature and overflowing with historical sites.

Togane is pretty much in the center of Chiba Prefecture and about 50km from the center of Tokyo. It has a population of about 60,000 and is blessed with a warm climate. The plains have good-quality fields spreading out toward the Pacific Ocean and the hills are covered by Sanbu Sugi (Cedar) forests.

A long time ago, in the Edo period, a relay station town and a town where wholesalers of agricultural products from neighboring areas formed in this area when the Onari Kaido highway was built for Tokugawa Ieyasu's falconry.

After that, Togane thrived as a collection and distribution point of goods and grew as the central city of the Kujukuri area. Today, it is an important point connecting National Route 126, the Chiba-Togane Road, and Metropolitan inter-city Expressway.

[Industry Festival]

An event held in late November, gathering Togane agricultural products, specialty products, and industrial products.

A popular spot for celebrating the first sunrise of the New Year.

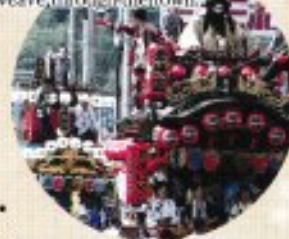


[Hetakata Lotuses]

At Lake Hakkaku in the center of Togane. From July to August, you can enjoy the lotus flowers up close from the wharf that is close to the surface of the water. Early morning is the best time.

[Hiyoshi Shrine Intervillage Festival]

Every other year the portable shrines go out on a procession, where the dashi and yakata, which are of a rare shape called Togane-gata, weave through the town.

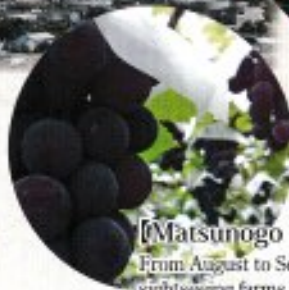


[Onari Kaido highway]



[YASSA Festival]

Togane's signature summer festival, held in mid-August. Participants proceed through the streets while dancing the Yassa Odori, a Bon dance. There are also fireworks.

From August to September, there are many sightseeing farms where you can pick grapes. This area is the prefecture's largest producer of grapes.
